Well here may be your big chance to share your knowledge and experience with an interested audience. ECBACC, Inc. is currently accepting submissions for workshop ideas from you; our devoted fans, friends and convention family; to be offered at the upcoming 9th Annual East Coast Black Age of Comics Convention on Saturday, May 15, 2010.

ECBACC is looking for workshops that can speak to our audience's interest and facilitators who can speak clearly, effectively, and can professionally convey their subject. The workshop and the facilitator must equally be able to address one of the following audience types:

- a) Youth (12 and under)
- b) Adults (Teens and up)
- c) General Audience (Youth, Adult, and Family)

All workshops should cover at least one of the following themes and activities:

- 1) How to draw comics
- 2) How to write comics
- 3) Comic book publishing 101
- 4) Black Images and Science Fiction
- 5) Popular fiction as a tool for education
- 6) Or something not currently listed but could benefit the ECBACC convention-goer

Your submission will be read and considered by the ECBACC, Inc. Board of Directors. Final selections will be judged using six (6) criteria:

- 1) **Relevancy** of proposed workshop to the ECBACC, Inc. Mission (Visit www.ecbacc.com if you need to brush up on why we do what we do.)
- 2) **Timeliness** of proposed workshop topic or subject matter (Whether the subject matter being taught or discussed has any current credibility)
- 3) **End Results** of the workshop activities (What will the prospective students in your class gain or walk away from your workshop with; i.e. a product or knowledge on an important topic, etc.)
- 4) **Qualifications** of the facilitator as one experienced in this subject and who has the ability to positively interact with the intended audience and convey a full lesson
- 5) **Viability** of proposed workshops logistical needs (If the physical materials needed to offer this workshop are available; e.g. paper, pencils, crayons, projector capability, computer needs, etc.)
- 6) **Availability** of time for the proposed workshop (In the event of receiving more workshop ideas than we can offer within our Saturday Convention time-slot, your submissions may not be chosen for this year).
